All <u>K-5 students</u> must be up-to-date on their immunizations before school starts. A "Green" immunization card must be filled out by the healthcare provider and turned in to the school to be kept in the child's permanent record.

Students entering into the <u>7th and 12th</u> grades must have boosters, and an "Orange" immunization card must be turned in to be kept in the student's permanent record.
