Tuition Reminder

Please remember that tuition is kept as low as possible. When families fall behind in their tuition payments, there may not be sufficient funds available to meet expenses. It is our desire as a ministry to maintain a good testimony with the business community by paying our bills on time. Your cooperation by making tuition payments on time helps us meet this goal.

IMMUNIZATIONS

All K-5 students must be up-to-date on their immunizations before school starts. A "Green" immunization card must be filled out by the healthcare provider and turned in to the school to be kept in the child's permanent record. Students entering into the 7th and 12th grades must have boosters, and an "Orange" immunization card must be turned in to be kept in the student's permanent record.
