All K-5 students must be up-to-date on their immunizations before school starts. A "Green" immunization card must be filled out by the healthcare provider and turned in to the school to be kept in the child's permanent record.

Students entering into the 7th and 12th grades must have boosters, and an "Orange" immunization card must be turned in to be kept in the student's permanent record.
